

our unhappiness is caused by our misplaced desire to return to the "good old days" - those times when we


enjoyed health, wealth, position, or power (Yes, I'm quilty). However, the things of this world will not last.

They are vacillating, and ever changing. In fact, if we live long enough, they could be taken away from us and replaced with poverty, isolation, weakness, and pain (cf. <u>Job 1:1-</u> <u>22</u>; Job 2:1-10).

When we realize that this world and everything in it is unstable and unpredictable, we might find ourselves asking, "Is there anything lasting?" The Psalmist answers: "His [God's] righteousness endures forever" (Psalm 112:9). It is untouched and unharmed by time and circumstances. Nothing that happens in this world can take it away. It endures when life has stripped us of every other possession.1
