NEWS FROM PARIS

Greetings to all of you beloved family in Christ and Friends,

By the time you receive this report I will have reached 70, and by the grace of God I am in good spiritual and physical health.

At last the work on the building is finished after over two months of work. It looks so nice that neighborhood businesses, neighbors and friends comment on how good it looks, and we are pleased.

The wife of the owner of the company who did our building, (after talking to her about the Bible) expressed the fact that she was always interested to learn more about God and the Bible. She and her husband are Muslims but not practicing. So at first, I gave her several tracts related to the Bible, and she liked them so much that after reading them, she gave them to her Muslim girlfriends. I, then offered her a BCC, which she accepted. After telling them that Rose teaches English classes free of charge, now one of their sons is taking English classes with Rose, using a Bible encyclopedia..

Brother Ken Wilson arrived as planned, so I went to pick him up at the train station, then, I went to the airport to pick up Brothers Haston Handley and Scott Ingram.

They stayed the weekend in Paris and on Monday morning I drove them with Ken to Caen. As soon as we arrived there, we put our bags at brother Stevin's place and went out to eat lunch. We started distributing BCC cards and talking to people. Since Haston and Scott could only stay one week

and were flying out Saturday we stayed till Friday morning and I drove them back to Paris so they could catch their flight the next day. While in Caen, we gave out 5,500 BCC Cards and 500 tracts and 600 invitations to a home Bible study. Brother Ken went out every morning to the University of Caen to give out tracts and Bibles and to talk to people even at the cafeteria to make contacts. The following week I went back to Caen with brother Jordy a wonderful young Christian man. It was a first experience for him in street Evangelism. He is shy, but he watched me, and did fine. For my third trip to Caen, I had decided to print cards about the World English Institute. I printed 600 of them and gave them to people in the streets but also placed them in Catholic church buildings.

I talked to a women professor of the university that spoke good English, after I gave her several tracts, she told me, "That she would pass them to her students to take the course". It was wonderful to hear that. I am grateful unto God that Ken consecrated a whole month to help Evangelize the city of Caen and also grateful that these two young preacher students from Memphis also helped us! We divided our work by sections of town and as we finished one area we marked it on the map so we knew which area we already covered. Here are the results of one month of evangelization. Four persons signed up for the Bible correspondence course, two French ladies, a woman from Cameroon and one young man from Nigeria. While at Stevin's place, he invited a friend of his that use to work with him. Kevin was born in Mauritius but was adopted by a French family at 5 months old! His adoptive family was very nice to him and never hid from him where he came from. So this year he decided to go there and meet his biological mother. It was quite an experience for him because he had not been back for 30years. Once he arrived he was quite surprised him to find out that he had 8 more brothers and sisters. His mother being a Hindu she took him to a temple and he decided to learn more about his mother's religion. I had prepared a meal and told Stevin to invite him for dinner, and when he came we had a long conversation and I explained to him the difference between Hinduism and Christianity. He listened so well that the following week he asked Stevin for a Bible so once again he came and stayed and ate with us, and promised that he would read the Bible.

Brother David Lanoix from Guadeloupe placed membership with us, as he is in training for 1 year in Paris to become a custom agent for the French government. We have known him and his family since the eighty's. A contact from the website from Ghana who lived in Paris for the last 15years visited the Ghanaian worship. He is a Pentecostal but has been disappointed by their teaching. I offered to study with him and his family.

Another young Ghanaian brother named Jerry who just arrived in France contacted me via the internet website so he could get the address of the church, since his initial contact he has been coming on a regular basis to worship.

To God be the glory on the April 25th Jess Amelia, 27 years old, was baptized for the remission of sin. Leiha Prez from Alabama placed membership with us, as she came to Paris for a month's study. Corinne Walser, 19 years old, from Switzerland also placed membership with us, and is here for studies for a year. Rubenson Ceus comes almost every day for Bible study with me, and it's encouraging to see a young zealous Christian like him in the Lord's Church.

Anna Yuropova from Russia, whom I baptized several years ago, was involved in the attack that happened in Saint Petersburg, but thank God she was not hurt but shocked.

Brother Samuel Milcent lost his father and flew to Haiti for the funeral. While gone, his Taxi was broken into and they stole 5,000 euros worth of equipment.

Several of our members are sick and needing our prayers, Brother Paul Besse with Kidney cancer, Brother John Fenestil still waiting for a kidney transplant, Sister Georgette René Gabriel with severe arthritis pains and fatigue, Daniel Vatin losing her eye sight and poor health.

Sister Olena Blagodarna from Ukraine who had just placed membership with us has moved back to Ukraine.

In the past three months more than 1,200 tracts was taken from our racks, by members and visitors and people from the street.

From the website in March 5,710 people visited from 87 nations. in April 5,662 people visited the website from 89 nations and in May 5,733 visited 82 countries. Because of the website several people have visited us.

As partner in spreading the Gospel of Christ in the French World, we want thank you for your support in so many ways!

May God richly bless you through 2017.
