Roland and I went to Rose Mary's for the 24th. We were allowed to stay late. On the 31st the curfew was for 8:00 P.M. Roland and I stayed home. We did get into Zoom and wish Happy New Year to Church members and friends.

We have lost beloved here and in the USA, family and church family as many of you have also. We buried our eldest member Ria Cumming aged 92 on the 31st. Roland also did the funeral for another member Alex Fequiere. I didn't go to the funeral of Alex as they only permitted so many people to attend because of the corona virus. I lost my dear Aunt



Mildred Byers on Jan.1st. My cousin Jeanne's husband fell in hospital in Ohio and died. Please pray for the families.

We were not allowed to meet for services as usual, but the Catholics put pressure on the govt., now we can have 70 people of course wearing masks, and distancing.

We lost 3 families moving out of Paris. The first one was Wally, Rachel and their twin boys to leave for Nigeria ! The other family was Ben and Rebecca Thomas, Brooklyn and Alexy. Annie, our Malaysian sister came to Paris for her studies, then she moved to Dijon to continue her studies. We miss all of them.

Our grandson Emmanuel, moved to Caen where he was able to get a job. That is where Stevin lives so they get together from time to time.

Roland had his hammer toe on his foot operated on and is doing well. The bone spur on other foot is not going to be operated on. This was on Jan 4th.

A few days ago, we had snow that didn't last at all. A couple days ago we had snow that laid and was so pretty in the city. I still have flowers blooming in the flower boxes.

We got to visit some with Enyo from Togo, Africa, one of our former members working with ladies and children in her own country.

Brother Pascal Prunier, from Troyes, France just lost his dad. He was planning on being here with us for worship and couldn't come because of that.

I have been working on some needlepoint and finished some. One I will need more thread. I have also been crocheting and have gifted some here with afghans. That is what Emmanuel, Lily Rose and Gabrielle got from Grandma this year.

Missed being with others but Roland and I had foi gras by ourselves and didn't have to go out in the cold for New Years day. It was very cold the day of Ria's funeral too!

Thank you all for the communication with us. We lost our dear sister in Christ, Doris Tuten in Tuscumbia, Al. too.
