



God is still having mercy on us, especially on this part of the divide. We are grateful to you all for taking times in your private and cooperate assembly, to commit us to God in prayers. Surely, your prayers have ascended to the throne of grace. It is on that note, we are alive today.

The church is matching forward spiritually, as no gate of hell shall prevail against it. Our duty is to ensure that the gospel is preached, souls who are saved are taught the value of God's salvation so that their faith will rest on God alone. It seems it is becoming increasingly difficult these days for people to accept the sound doctrine. Well, discouragement I realize is one of Devil's tools to hinder the work of God. This class has helped members to try to take care of their extended relations as well. Some of the relations are close to us, but far away from God. It is also part of our duties, having enjoyed our sins forgiven, to point our relations to the cross of Jesus. I have also been teaching Sunday class at Mazah Road congregation throughout the month of May. So, for the month of May, I taught 8 bible classes, and preached three time.

Our weekend evangelism outreach continues at Foron Mission congregation, except for last weekend (29th May, 2021) when the church joined the New Foron Village, at the burial of the late brother. We are sharing tracts and discussing the Bible with willing hearts. We also share our correspondence courses to our prospects.

Brethren, situation in Nigeria is getting bad every day. I refuse to say that everything is bad, because in every situation, there are good plans of God. Security situation is worrisome, as traveling on the road is almost a suicide mission. I am particularly grateful to God for his protection every week, as we drive to Foron and return to Jos safely. Living in the inner city is not safe neither. Kidnapping of school children is reported on daily basis. Killing of innocent people by the Islamic terrorist groups has become the normal thing, yet the government is not sincere in its fight against the insurgencies. We need your prayers daily. Economically, life is difficult as farmers cannot enter farm again because of the killings by the Islamic terrorist. We cannot stop the work of spreading the gospel, because the devil wants to frighten us to ensure that more people die without hearing the gospel. Who knows when they will be convinced and be converted. We will refuse to be frighten. Death surely will come when it will come. As long as we live, the gospel of Christ for the salvation of man must be preached by me and my family. My students at the School of Biblical Studies, sharing this same conviction have gone for holiday, but with their Bible open daily to study with ready souls.

Please, pray for us to continue to have opportunity to share the gospel with those who long for salvation. May God continue to bless you all in good work.
