Dear beloved family and friends,

Greetings to all of you. September and October were traveling times, first to the USA to take care of papers, driver license for Rose and dental work for me. We came back to France and after a week we headed to Saint Ambroise, Canada by Lake Sagenay, for the official inauguration of the church building where Brother Jean Grenier and his family started the work there 12 years ago. He bought a house and an old garage next to it which was actually an old stable. With the help of several Christians he finally was able to make the place into a nice meeting place for the Church. It took him a long time before he got the green light from the government to officially recognize the place as a church building. He still has some work to be done on it, but it will take more time and money to completely finish it. His goal is to have a Bible

school training in French, a place for a retreat for the Canadian brotherhood and also a Bible camp.

Once we arrived, and after we settled in, I immediately got busy to organize and plan for the meals since I had to cook for 85 people. Not having an equipped kitchen I had to improvise, but used lots of Ann's, (Jean Grenier's wife) kitchen utensils, even though it was not professional equipment, I adapted myself and made it work!

We went to the post office to mail the 4,000 invitations for the inauguration. He also advertised through Facebook and anybody that we met in the street or business places, we invited them and gave an invitation.

The following day Brother Robert Mc Cready former missionary to France and presently a teacher at Harding University came with a group to sing and help get everything ready. Robert was scheduled to speak twice and I twice and Jean too.

The day of the inauguration we were altogether 52 people present which is good for Canada and out of the 52 present, 12 were visitors and that included the mayor of the town and his wife. Out of the 12 visitor, 4 were good prospect for Bible study.

Brother Jean Marie drove 450 kilometers to come and help Jean for two months and was there once before for another month. A wonderful brother really dedicated to the Lord's work.

The menu I planned was as follows: small individual dishes of Taboulie, Hommous, Eggplant caviar and Mauritius Island Achar. With the chicken Basquaise I made rice Pilaf and a composed salad.

For the dessert I had a cake called "La Tropezienne" filled with cream, than Tart Tatin, Cherry and Strawberry cheesecake and a specialty of my father's country called "Sabaya" made with flour honey butter eggs and lots of TLC. And for coffee break I made "Horn of the Desert", which were delicious cookies shaped like horns. Rose helped me and almost made all the horn cookies by herself. These cookies are made with dates, walnut, pecans, hazelnut butter, sugar, eggs, and once they are baked I rolled them in white powder sugar. The following days I made spaghetti with homemade sauce and garlic bread, and meat loaf with mashed potatoes. Everyone appreciated all the food that I made with the help of Rose.

I am grateful unto God that I had the opportunity to be able to help the Church there. We are thankful that Jean took time to come to pick us up and take us back to the airport. Jean would love for Rose and I to come and work with him, but I told I would love to, except for one thing, the minus 30 degree temperatures sometimes in Winter.

On our trip back to Paris seems like someone took my camera inside the plane; the sad part is all the pictures I took and don't have any more.

Then I discovered on coming back from America that my computer crashed with everything in it. It just happened before we flew to Canada and therefore lost everything, so I have been without a computer for one and half months. Thank God for Brother Franck Delormel who rebuilt it for me.

Now some wonderful news, three precious souls added to the Lord's kingdom, first Sophia Mesli the French lady who was an initial contact of the church website. She was baptized on September 27nd. Alex Richard Lymat and his fiancé Jessica both were baptized after 13 hours of Bible studies over three days with me.



They were in hurry to put on Christ, because they were heading to Australia where work was waiting for them. They have engineer degrees, and they already have contacted the Church there by internet. This brings us to a total of 9 baptisms so far this year. The organization and program for the November 11th retreat which is held in Lille, North France, was our responsibility for the program and the theme for this year, was 1 Peter 2:9-10. A chosen people.

We are indeed grateful unto God who gives us the privilege to serve Him and will continue to do so until the day HE will call us to go home to be with Him eternally.

We are grateful for all of you who make possible for us to continue to serve him and we are grateful for all your prayers especially in this time of unsecured stability all over the world.

May God shower blessings and good health upon each and every one of you.
