

Dear family in Christ and friends,

It's our prayer that this report will find you in good health physical and spiritual. Since the confinement we have been under for several months and we are aware that it's worldwide and in even worse in some countries. We are grateful that the French government has removed some of the constraining rules. When they first put it in place, we were only allowed to go out our house for one hour and could only go for a distance of 1 kilometre and with a signed authorisation which stated for which reason , either grocery shopping , doctor visits or taking your pet for a walk and, of course, wearing of the mask was mandatory. If you got stopped by the police without a mask and your authorisation you got a fined \$200.00! The police caught close to one million people without masks. On June the second, the government announced that we could now travel up to 100 kilometres but with only two people in our cars, the driver and a person in the back seat. But in regards to the Church we could start meeting but no more ten people at the time, and no children under the age of eleven.

Thank God for Zoom, Google Meeting, and Skype. We have worship and are having Bible classes through their services. Tuesday evening I have a Bible class with the Church in Cameroun and we have an average of 12-14 present and for the last three weeks a family from Italy joining us for the Bible study which is good for them.

On Wednesday we have a Bible class with our members and also with brethren from Guadeloupe, Martinique, and Saint Marten and Brother Steven from Caen, France. Sunday morning we have an average of 53 to 54 families including brother Steven from Caen and the family from Cuba living near Toulouse, and for the evening English worship through Zoom and we have an average 8 to 9 connected.

June the 9th four brethren and a sister came to the building so we can prepare the meeting place so we could accommodate for a maximum of 70 people compared to the 180 before to the confinement. More good news; now we can travel more than 1000 kilometres from home. We cannot travel outside of the country and no one can come to France from another country. The schools reopened on June the second but with a limited number of children by classes. Our granddaughters have school three times a week with a limited amount of students.

Through our website I have several people taking Bible correspondence courses and one particular lady is really a good student. Brother Pascal from Troyes continues to stay in contact with us and Zoom for worship. Prices of goods have skyrocketed and unemployment rate here in France is worst that is ever been since the end of WWII. They expect thousands of businesses will be bankrupted in the next few months. The only thing that went down a little is gasoline.

We are grateful unto God that none of us or our family has caught the Corona virus that we are sure of.

We are grateful unto you all that continue to support us spiritually and materially
