We thank God because last year, it was difficult for families to meet because of corona virus spread. Even though the problem is still there, we praise God for reducing the cases, and allowing us the opportunity of meeting together. We give thanks to God for seeing us through the month of March into the month of April. In fact, the first quarter is gone, and we are left with less than 9 months to actualize our plans for the year. We appreciate every one of you for taking time to pray for us in Africa. God's work has to be done while it is day, because night comes in our life that we won't be able to do anything again. It is sad that so many people do not have this knowledge, that is why things are happening the way they are happening everywhere in the world. Our mission is to turn people's eyes from darkness to the Light. And it is

more necessary that we continue to see each day as a fresh opportunity to key into this global mission.



Over the month of March, I was able to teach 8 Bible classes in 3 different congregations. My Friday class with Mazah Road Church on Christians Responsibilities their own is on progress. My class on the Church of the Bible with Foron Mission congregation is still on course, though I have to teach two weeks with

Foron Mission and two weeks with New Village Foron. With the reduction in the cases of covid 19, and further relaxation of some of the stringent rules, we have resumed partially our face to face evangelism contacts. The Lord added a soul to those being saved. Below is the newly baptized sister.

Please, let us keep praying for. Already, she is complaining that her family is beginning to persecute her. But the interesting thing is that she is of age and has taken her stand in Christ to remain a Christian. Sandra is continuing with her sisters' class with Mazah Road Church of Christ. Sister Marci, a visiting missionary to the School of Biblical Studies, Jos, is joining her every week. Sandra now has some encouragement from her, as she helps in handling some topics and answering questions.

At the School of Biblical Studies, Jos, our classes are progressing well. God is answering our prayers.

Despite the wide spread of insecurity in Nigeria, Jos is peaceful for now. There are cases of kidnapping in Nigeria, especially in the northern Nigeria. It is difficult to go through Nigerian roads, but God is helping us as we hit the road to Foron Mission and New Village Foron every week. In the next three weeks, Lord's willing, the students of the School of Biblical Studies are hoping to start their final exams. That will mark the end of this academic year, 2020/21. It is sad enough that we will not be going on usual evangelism campaign for Christ this year, and will not have our annual Gospel Lectureship and graduation ceremony, all because the Government has not relaxed rule on crowd gathering. The insecurity on its own side has contributed to the cancellation of this year's evangelism campaign, where we are supposed to leave Jos for 9 days knocking doors. All these are Satan's strategies to delay the work of God. But we however, will continue the evangelism within Jos, Foron and its environs if God permits us.

Let me at this moment request for your prayers for my parents here in Nigeria. My father was hospitalized last week, we thank God he has been discharged as she battles with Blood pressure and diabetic mellitus. My mother since she had a partial stroke last year, is still not fine. Join me in prayer that they will age gracefully. Permit me to use this time to appreciate you all for your support. Your labor of love will never go unrewarded by God Almighty. Keep praying for us to use every resource available to us to spread the Gospel and keep the saved saved in Christ.
