REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF FEBRUARY, 2020 (TOM EKPOT JR)

Dear Brethren,

Greetings to you all in Jesus name. It is by His grace that we are part of this last month of the first quarter. We owe him our lives and duty. Thank you for your individual and collective prayers for us and the work in Nigeria and Cameroon. God is working through you in different ways. We sympathize with the families of those affected by the Nashville disaster. Each day, we wake up with new happenings. At any rate, we thank God because not every day is bad with every one of us. We equally sympathize with the families of the victims of the dreaded corona virus. We pray God should intervene before more destruction are experienced.

Since the emergence of the deadly COVID 19, the whole world is now living in fear. Lifestyles have been redefined. The usual handshake is no more freely exchanged, and people are trying to avoid where there is crowd. The lazy ones now have reason they should not attend fellowship. It shows the love people have for physical living. It is amazing that these same people pay no attention to warnings against eternal condemnation. Maybe because they are too familiar with the truth of the Gospel, to the extent that they don't take God serious again. We will continue to herald the message of salvation and warning against irresponsible living. The Bible says, in everything, we should give thanks to God, because this is the will of God for us. Though corona virus is not good, and cannot be good, however, this happens to remind us of the existence of God who has the final power and knowledge. He only reveals what He wants man to know at a time. Because of man's micro knowledge, man begins to think that he has control of the universe. On every weekend, I travel through dangerous roads to meet with the local congregations, yet God's faithfulness never ceases. Join me in giving thanks to God.

Because of the economic situation world over, we add to our training, vegetable production. We teach our preachers under training the need to use their hands. Below is a picture of students making raised beds to plant vegetables.

The soil in Jos is rocky and dry, it means that the vegetables will be watered manually. We use buckets to



improvise for drip irrigation. At least, with this the students can plant the vegetables they need instead of spending

money they don't have to buy it.

At Mazah Road Church of Christ, I am glad to mention that we are witnessing some remarking numerical and spiritual growth. Our Friday Bible study now has more members attending. We have many members coming out for evangelism. I have printed 3 additional tracts. It has been difficult to get tracts from the States, so I thought it necessary to locally produce the tracts on the topics that are important to us here. I have produced 3,000 copies. There is need that I reprint more copies because the 3,000 remain only few copies, as other congregations in Jos also came for some. We have to use all the available means to send the light. Millions of people are in dark, groping without the Gospel. Aside from door knocking, we also study by mails. We have lessons like the WBS, that we give to prospects whom we can not sit with them for reasons. It is interesting to mention here that a soul was won to Christ, in the person of Grace Godwin. Grace is a teenage girl in the high school. Let's continue to pray for her.

At Foron Mission, we are handling the Sermon on the Mount. We concluded the Church of the New Testament last years, and the Church decided to deal with life in the Kingdom. Our children class is getting more kids weekly. Sandra wants to start women Bible class on Sundays for them. This is tasking in view of the distance we drive to the village. It is difficult for her to go there during the week days because of the distance and the insecurity along the road. Already, she is having class for the sisters at Mazah Road Church of Christ every Saturday, and the class is gaining interest.

May I use this opportunity to appreciate you all for your support despite the difficult economic time confronting you. May God continue to reward you richly, even as you sacrificially make to contribution for the work of the Gospel. May I also use this opportunity to plead with you for prayers for my mother, who is currently sick. Last Friday, February 28, 2020 she fell down, and rushing her to a nearby hospital, it was discovered that she has high BP that caused her stroke. I know God can help her regain herself. At the moment, she can't speak clearly, she can't walk neither. We long to for Jesus return, where all these problems will not be mentioned again. We have to work with disciplined mind in this crooked generation to be at the right hand of God. I equally call for prayers even as I travel to Sierra Leone and Guinea to speak in their Lectureships. This comes at time traveling is dangerous because of the outbreak of Corona virus. But remembering that Jesus gave up everything for us to be saved, is an encouragement for me to travel despite the risk. Have a great month ahead.
