Our children are back to doing lessons from home and this should be for at least a month. This is our 3rd confinement. We aren't allowed but 10 kilometres from where we live.

My friend Josiane lost a longtime friend of hers about 8 days ago. My cousin Al in Pennsylvania died of covid in the hospital. My cousin Helen his wife has it but is getting better.
