REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF MAY, 2017 (TOM EK POT JR)

Greetings to you all in the precious name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, whose death on the cross gives us hope unimaginable. May the grace of God reach all of us. If life does not give us what we want yet we can praise God because we are alive. I appreciate you individually and collectively for standing by us to preach the Gospel in Africa. May our Good Lord continue to bless you in every good way. May He meet your daily needs for good.

The month of May was one month that kept me so busy. I am grateful that God gave me and my family the grace and opportunity to be part of all that went on to His glory. Though hectic, the month went so fast. May marks the onset of rainy season in the Northern Nigeria. Farmers get into farm to sow seed. Incidentally, it coincided with the campaign evangelism program of the School of Biblical Studies, Jos. We went to several places in the Country sowing seed of the kingdom. From 6th to 14th May, I led a team of 9 evangelists to Lafia, the capital city of Nasarawa State. It was a successful outing, not only because people obeyed the Gospel, but because we sowed the

indestructible seed that can serve man in the hearts of men and women in this city. Lafia, being highly dominated by the Muslims was a little challenging with obstacles peculiar to such places. However, none of our students was hurt. I ran into a teenage boy who unfortunately joined some bad boys after his father's death. He confessed to committing several crimes because of the group he found himself. Glory be to God, he willingly gave himself to Christ and pleads for God's mercy. Interestingly, the members of the Church of Christ, Lafia were with us. They will continue with the studies we established, especially with this boy. We give glory to God because out of the several studies conducted, four people obeyed the gospel and were baptized for the forgiveness of their sins. We had open-air preaching for two nights. This was necessary because some people whom we could not reach because of their work, found opportunity to come by in the night on their return. Secondly, some people who would not want to study with us in the day preferred night. We had to make opportunity for them all. The two nights were exiting because people came with several questions bothering on salvation. I stood for 1:30 answering questions the first day. It was an interesting program on the whole. At the end of the one week exercise of intensive door-knocking and open-air preaching, we were able to set up 179 studies with 474 people, with 4 people yielding their obedience to Christ.

On the 17-19th May, we had our annual Gospel lectureship. Several men and women across the nation attended the program.
