OUR FAITH IS NOT BLIND! Joe Slater



Skeptics of various types routinely mock Christians for having "blind faith." Unfortunately, may professing Christians have fed that myth by

basing their faith (if you can even call it that) on their feelings. Ask them why they believe as they do, and their answer is, "I feel it right here in my heart!" Even some of the songs we sing betray this notion. One quick example: I Serve a Risen Savior has this line at the end of the chorus: "You ask me how I know He lives? He lives within my heart!"

Does Jesus live within your heart? Assuredly so! But is that how you know He lives? Certainly not! You would know nothing of His death, burial, and resurrection but for the fact that God has revealed it in



His word! Because His word has been revealed, confirmed, and recorded, our faith rests on solid

evidence; it is definitely not blind! And when we put our confident trust in Jesus and obey His will, we ought to feel good about it! But let's keep things in order: first come the facts (as revealed in the Bible, John 17:17); then comes faith, which is based on the facts (Rom. 1:16); finally come good feelings (Acts 8:39). Facts, faith, and feelings, in that order.

When feelings are the basis for faith, we're on dangerous ground! Saul of Tarsus felt like he was



doing right by persecuting Christians. Islamic jihadists feel like they are doing right by blowing themselves up to kill Jews and Christians. Those feelings are as real as yours. If feelings are the basis for acceptable faith, then we

should honor those behaviors! (But they aren't!) Bottom line, a Christian's faith isn't blind, but rests on the rock-solid evidence of the revealed, confirmed, recorded word of God.
