May God continue to bless each and everyone of you in every good way.

The month of November is one month in my life history that I cherish so much. On the 9th November 2020, I will be marking 24 years in marriage. My younger son Godswill, will be 20 years on the 11th of this month. I thank God for His grace all these years. I cannot name the number of times we have escaped murder by Islamic militants and robbers on the highway. God has been faithful in protecting us and supplying our needs. I continue to pray that God will also see you all through in your various challenges. I pray especially as Winter season deepens that God will spare his elects from the spread of corona virus. I equally pray that the present election will be peaceful to the end. Millions of people across the globe look up to America for many things. May God secure America for His use.

The month of October in Nigeria was one month that many people experience so much chaos. From the insecurity to

the attacks against innocent people, leading to the death of so many persons in some states of the country. The level of hardship in the country has in the last few months increased to a level that some people cannot bear again. The picture seen below shows young people who discovered where the Plateau State Government stored food that was meant to be shared during the covid 19 lockdown. The young people broke into the warehouse to pack the palliatives. Young and old people were seen scrambling for whatever they can pick from the warehouse. Some people climbed the roof of the house to make opening through the roof. Some people were stampeded to death on account of trying to get a 50kg of maize grain. Please, continue to pray for us.



We give glory to God because the Plateau State Government has authorized the re-opening of schools across the state. So, the school of Biblical Studies, Jos has re-opened fully for academic activities. Our weekly school evangelism cannot take off this two months remaining. During the past four months, we brought in our returning students level by level to ensure we do not miss the semester completely. The returning students were able to take their classes and exams, and have since returned home. That helped us ensure social distancing even as the new intakes have just resumed. Since it is our practice to pair the old and the new students for evangelism, and now the old students are not around, it becomes difficult to send the new ones who do not know the city demography to go alone. The insecurity in the Northern Nigeria calls for wisdom on where one goes at any given time. In the next few weeks, we will be taking our training to local preachers and teacher who cannot afford to leave their homes to Jos. We are having training of preachers and teachers in 4 centers this November through December. Please, keep praying for us.

The congregations in Foron (New Foron Village and Foron Mission) are doing well. The lockdown had offered us opportunity to have our children classes continuously with those students in the high school who are on boarding. But the reopening of schools, they have to leave until Christmas holiday before we meet with them again. Though corona virus is not good and will never be good, I realized the application of Romans 8.28 during the lockdown. God gave us the opportunity to mentor and model these children for Christ for such a continuous long period, which we never had it so before. Two of those in the high school were baptized during this period.

The congregation at Mazah road is also doing well. My weekly Friday Bible Study is in progress. This time we are dealing with "Governing our Attitudes." The lesson has proved to be helpful to us in view of the excesses that are happening in the Northern Nigeria. Our evangelism by correspondence is in progress especially in Foron area. As the year 2020 approaches it end, there is need for us to look back and see how we fair during the year. God has been gracious to us in different ways. We will continue to give praise to God irrespective of the circumstances of life.

I wish you all a happy Thanksgiving celebration ahead. I pray that God will help us keep our faith unshaken in face of earthly terror. I wish you all a happy November 2020.
